Delegation of Authority--Amendments to the Capital Improvement Program for Non-State-Funded Minor Capital Improvement Projects

Under Section 100.4(q) of the Standing Orders of The Regents, the President is authorized to approve amendments to the Capital Improvement Program for projects costing up to and including \$10 million, except when in the judgment of the President, a project merits review and approval by The Regents because of special circumstances related to budget matters, external financing, fundraising activities, project design, environmental impacts, community concerns, or substantial program modifications.

Effective immediately, you are delegated authority to approve amendments to the Capital Improvement Program for non-State-funded minor capital improvement projects (total project cost not to exceed \$400,000) within your areas of responsibility with the exception of (1) any substantial program modification of a project previously approved by The Regents or the Vice President--Budget; (2) any project which was denied funding by the State; or (3) any project costing over \$25,000 involving Chancellorial residences or offices. Category (3) projects will require prior approval by the President, and will be reported to The Regents annually in September. Further, any project costing over \$400,000 is subject to the parameters of DA 2159 (3/22/2006).

Any project with the potential for significant environmental impact is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act. Therefore, there is no guarantee that projects added to the Capital Improvement Program list will necessarily proceed to construction. The decision to proceed occurs at the design approval stage and must be accompanied by appropriate environmental information. Authority for project design approval is addressed in DA 2136 (2/26/2003).

The above authorities are granted with the understanding that funding from non-State sources complies with Presidential or Regental policy governing use of such funds.

You may redelegate this authority within the above parameters, or within more restrictive parameters. Any such re delegation shall be in writing, with copies to the Vice President for Budget and the Universitywide Policy Coordinator.

This delegation supersedes the February 28, 2002 delegation to Chancellors and the Vice President--Agriculture and Natural Resources on the same subject (DA 2126).
