<u>Delegation of Authority – To Solicit and Execute Certain Changes with Respect to the</u> <u>Project Entitled Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder and Traumatic Brain Injury (PTSD/TBI)</u> <u>#W81XWH-08-2-0159</u>

Standing Order of The Regents 100.4 (dd) states that:

Except as otherwise specifically provided in the Bylaws and Standing Orders, the President is authorized to execute on behalf of the Corporation all contracts and other documents necessary in the exercise of the President's duties, including documents to solicit and accept pledges, gifts, and grants...

Specific exceptions to the President's authority for matters under 100.4(dd) are enumerated therein.

On March 10, 1995, the President delegated authority to Chancellors to solicit and accept or execute extramural grants and contracts for research if direct costs in any one project year did not exceed \$5,000,000 (DA 2036).

Because the named project exceeded this limit, the President approved the initial solicitation and executed a contract on behalf of the San Diego campus with the U.S. Army Medical Research and Materiel Command in the amount of \$59,958,866.00 for a 60-month period commencing September 15, 2008.

Effective immediately, as Chancellor of the San Diego campus, you are authorized to solicit and execute any amendments, modifications, or renewals subsequent to the initial award provided the general intent and purpose of the program remain unchanged from those originally approved.

Any redelegation of this authority shall be in writing, with copies to the General Counsel and Vice President for Legal Affairs and the Universitywide Policy Office.
