Dear Colleagues:

I am writing to inform you of the organizational changes in the Office of the President relative to responsibility for conflict of interest matters.

I have assigned to Senior Vice President Brady the responsibility, previously held by former Vice President Kleingartner, for conflict of interest matters requiring compliance with the Political Reform Act, excluding those matters that are related to financial disclosure by principal investigators.

I have assigned to Senior Vice President Frazer the responsibility for all matters related to financial disclosure by principal investigators as required by University policy and by Section 18705 of Title 2 of the California Administrative Code, promulgated in response to the Political Reform Act. University policy and implementing guidelines, issued on April 8 and 9, 1982, respectively, are set forth in the "University Policy on Disclosure of Financial Interests in Private Sponsors of Research" and the "Guidelines for Disclosure and Review of Principal Investigators' Financial Interests in Private Sponsors of Research."

Each Senior Vice President will represent the University before the Fair Political Practices Commission, the agency responsible for implementing the Political Reform Act, and will serve as the principal link with the Commission and with you in his respective area of responsibility.
