Delegation of Authority—Authority to Act for the President

To ensure that the University always has in the Office of the President an Officer with authority to act on necessary matters, Standing Order of The Regents 100.4, Duties of the President of the University, provides in (a) as follows:

* * *

... The President may delegate any of the duties of the office except service as an ex officio Regent.

* * *

In my absence or in case of my inability to act, I hereby delegate authority to the Provost and Executive Vice President—Academic Affairs to act for me in the exercise of the President's duties other than service as an ex officio Regent. When both the Provost and I are absent, the Executive Vice President—Business Operations is empowered to act for me. In the event of my absence and the absences of the Provost and the Executive Vice President—Business Operations, the Senior Vice President—External Relations is authorized to act for me. In the event of my absence and the absences of the Provost, the Executive Vice President—Business Operations, and the Senior Vice President—External Relations, the General Counsel and Vice President for Legal Affairs is authorized to act for me.

This delegation supersedes the previous delegation of authority dated July 24, 2008 (DA 2205). You may not further redelegate this authority.

In all cases, matters requiring the President's action or the President's signature shall be presented to my staff for orderly disposition.
