The Committee on Educational Policy presents the following:

A. <u>Proposed Research Contract: Spectroscopic Investigations with a Reflection Grating Spectrometer on the ESA X-Ray Multi-Mirror Mission, Berkeley Campus</u>

The Committee recommends that the President be authorized to solicit, approve, and execute a new contract from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration for a research project entitled Spectroscopic Investigations with a Reflection Grating Spectrometer on the ESA X-Ray Multi-Mirror Mission, under the direction of Professor Stephen M. Kahn of Samuel Silver Space Sciences Laboratory, Berkeley campus, in the approximate amount of \$18.8 million in constant 1989 dollars (estimated to total \$23 million in actual dollars) during a period of nine years and eight months commencing October 1, 1989, and to solicit, approve, and execute any subsequent amendments, modifications, or renewals thereto, provided the general intent and purpose of the project remain unchanged from those originally approved by The Regents.
