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I. POLICY SUMMARY

This policy has been rescinded.

As it was written, RMP-8 largely restated state and federal laws that apply to the University, including the California Public Records Act, the California Education Code, California Information Practices Act of 1977, the Federal Privacy Act of 1974, and the Federal Family Education Rights and Privacy Act of 1974.

In principle, policy is unnecessary to direct the University to comply with law, although supporting materials to assist with compliance are appropriate and helpful. Thus, in place of RMP-8, a website was created to provide the University community with updated information about legal requirements for information privacy, including updated examples of privacy notices and disclosures.
